1. Poster session will be held Friday, March 23rd, 2018 at the Best Western Plus Ramkota Hotel and Conference Center in Sioux Falls, SD from 12:15 PM to 1:15 PM.
2. Posters should be set up between 7:30 AM and 8:00 AM on Friday morning. Posters must be taken down by 3:15 PM.
3. A poster board (40 inches high and 60 inches wide) and easel will be provided. Please bring pins to attach the poster to the board.
4. To register your poster, please complete the form found below and submit to Gary Van Riper at gvrdsu@gmail.com If you will have more than one poster, please submit a form for each poster by the deadline. **NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 20th, 2018.**

1. To be entered into the poster competition, email an electronic version of your poster to Jennifer Ball (jennifer.ocallaghan@sdstate.edu) by **March 12th, 2018**. Electronic posters will be sent to the judges prior to the conference to expedite the judging process during the conference.
2. Finalists from the poster competition will be asked to provide a 2-minute presentation of the poster during the break from 3:15 PM to 3:45 PM on March 23rd. There will be an award for best poster. Participation in the poster competition is voluntary. Finalists will be announced on March 23rd at the SDSHP Annual Meeting Awards Presentation.
